

## CARME (MALLORCA) and MARINA ( CROATIA)

We started the lesson with **Powerpoint presentation about Mallorca**. Students were discussing what they know about Spain, Mallorca, they were asking Carme what she knows about Croatia. During the presentation we were making short pauses so that students could talk about **differences and similarities** between these two countries.

Carme highlighted **environmental issues** that happen in Mallorca. There are severe floods that happen more often in the last few years and devastating storms that happen in a case of a cold front.

Carme was talking about **„door to door“ recycling** in Mallorca. Students had to talk in pairs about the way they recycle (if they live in a house, in a flat, „Green island in Osijek“) in Osijek too see if there are some similarities or differences.

Because the trees are important for visual appearance of the city, for the wood industry, oxygen production there was a **“Tree presentation”** that presented destroyed olive trees in Mallorca, platana and oak trees that are being destroyed recently in our city.

After the presentation pupils in pairs or in smaller groups had to write down the answers to the question **“Is the recycling important for the trees, why?”**

**“Eco friendly machine”** was our last craft activity. In **grattage technique** students were drawing a machine that can solve ecology problems and they were explaining how it works, how this machine makes our environment better.

On Thursday, there was an **evaluation questionnaire and a rhyme or a slogan** (students were doing in pairs) that sums up the Tuesday lessons.
